At the beginning of 2018, CAMPO will be launching the planning process for the region's first ever Regional Arterial Plan. The plan purpose is to understand the existing role and function of the region's major arterial corridors and to define their future role(s) and function(s) by mode. The Regional Arterial Plan will include a facilities inventory, a review of the most current applicable regional policies and data, 2045 illustrative and priority networks, guidance and recommendations on facility design and policy, performance measures, and an implementation plan with project and policy priorities for the next 25 years.
